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#### **AUTUMN COVID BOOSTER PROGRAMME**

As promised in our Summer Newsletter, we are now able to give you further information regarding your Covid Booster vaccination.

If you are eligible, you should receive an Invitation to Book your Covid appointment either by telephoning 119 or on-line, via the NHS booking Site. The system is slightly different this time round as Chippenham, Corsham and Box Primary Care Networks will not be offering the COVID Autumn boosters.

There are several sites vaccinating locally. You can choose the best venue for you. These include Shaunaks in Corsham and Bath Racecourse.

However, all housebound and care home patients within the PCN will be contacted by the Bath Racecourse team and will receive their vaccination at home.

The range of eligible patients is:

- residents in a care home for older adults and staff working in care homes for older adults
- frontline health and social care workers
- all adults aged 50 years and over
- persons aged 5 to 49 years in a clinical risk group
- persons aged 5 to 49 years who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression
- persons aged 16 to 49 years who are carers

Over the last 2 years we have vaccinated more people than ever against the flu and had some of the best vaccine uptake levels we have ever seen!

We will be running a number of in-practice flu clinics as well as our Drive Through flu clinics at Abbeyfield School. These have been extremely successful over the last few years! As always, these vaccinations will be available by appointment only. We are, unfortunately, not able to offer a walk in influenza vaccine service. Our housebound patients are being contacted by our designated housebound flu teams.



A Message to all our patients from Natasha Moore, Operations Development Supervisor at HMC, regarding the new Community Pharmacy Consultation service

The Community Pharmacy Consultation Service (CPCS) is a new service where GP surgeries can send electronic referrals to community pharmacies for minor illnesses such as a rash/cough/sore throat etc.

This service has been funded to relieve pressure on GP practices by referring patients to have a consultation with a pharmacist where otherwise they would have attended their GP practice for an appointment. Once the referral has been completed by our reception or info suite team, pharmacies have a four-hour time frame to give the patient a call back, where the pharmacist will speak to the patient to discuss their symptoms. They will give the patient advice and see the patient face-to-face if appropriate, and advise of an over-the-counter treatment, if appropriate.

Chippenham Pharmacy and Health Clinic, a new distance-selling pharmacy on Bumper's Farm, have prescribing pharmacists which means we can refer for additional illnesses such as UTIs and eye infections. If appropriate, they will refer back to the surgery with the outcome of the referral and advise if antibiotics or a further appointment with a GP is needed.
